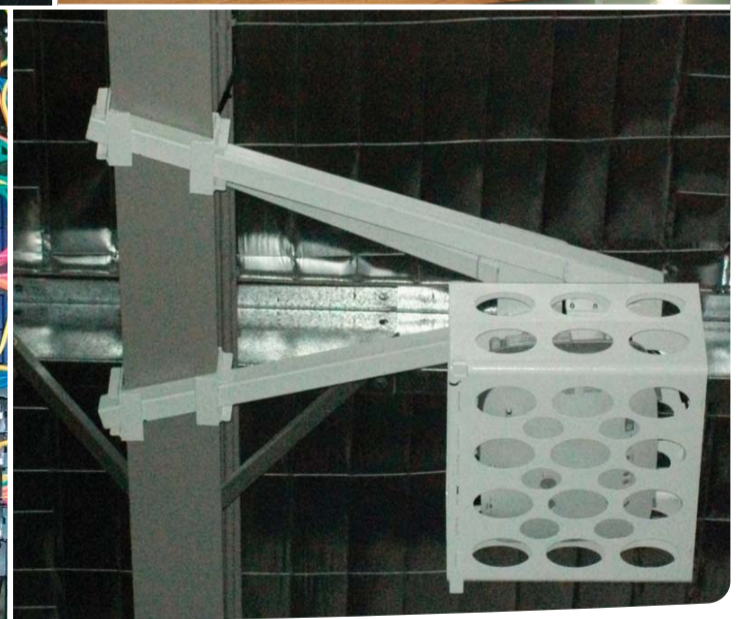
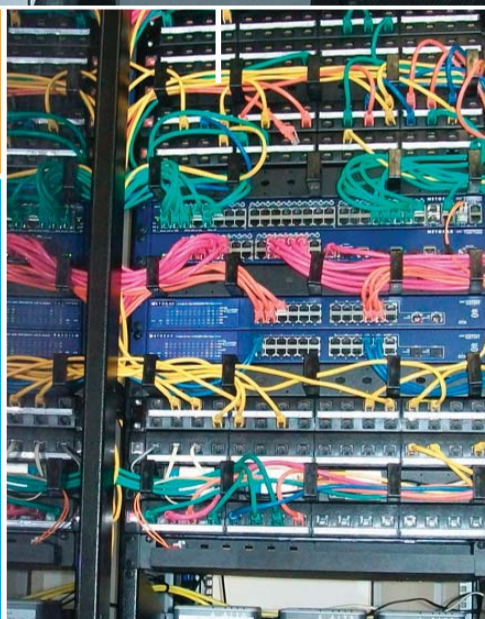

In essence, each of the three organizations would have its own private network but also the benefit of shared physical infrastructure including printers, network cabling and telephone system etc, all located in one building.

We successfully delivered to brief (on time and on budget) and were also involved in advising and selecting the telephone system; fibre optic cabling; supplying and installing a 250" motorized projector screen with suitable short throw projector for the Great Hall (including designing and fabricating a large bracket to mount this to a structural beam without compromising the beam integrity); NEC Digital Messaging System for displaying real time Building Management information at various locations around the complex; and even assisting with the provision of 5 star energy rated desks for the CAD room designed and manufactured in Melbourne by Sakimoto (www.sakimoto.com.au).
